# <u>Progress</u> Progress

We have heard your feedback about frustrations with Schoology, especially with the app's functionality. As a result, we have moved away from Schoology this year.

For **Communication**, we will be utilizing email (PowerSchool and/or Google platforms).

For **student grade reporting**, we will now be using **PowerTeacher**, which is the same program that Middle and High Schools use. This will create consistency for families as students move through our school division.

In the coming weeks, we will share more information about PowerSchool and PowerTeacher - specifically, how to view your child's progress online. Thank you for your patience and support as we make these improvements.

### <u>Student Fees & Field Trip Forms - IMPORTANT - ACTION REQUIRED</u>

RDCRS is once again using RYCOR Online Payments for our School Fees and RYCOR Online Forms for our field trip consents. Please see the information below!

- \* NEW this year is a \$30 Student Activity Fee that will be applied to each student account and can be processed through our online payment system. This fee is to help offset some of the rising costs of the activities provided to students (field trips/bus transportation, guest speakers, school wide events, etc.) Please complete the online payment by following these steps:
  - Log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal on a web browser NOT the app - https://rdcrs.powerschool.com/public/home.html (If you do not remember your username or password, please contact the office).
  - Scroll down and choose School Fees and Forms (second from the bottom, on the left)
  - Select the student name from the top banner
  - Select Due Now from the top menu bar and add the \$30 Student Activity Fee to your cart
  - Click on the cart icon on the top right and then complete the payment information. You will be emailed a receipt after you have submitted payment.

Methods of online payment include Visa, Visa Debit, Mastercard and Mastercard Debit. Please note, Interac Debit cards cannot be processed online at this time

\* Also NEW this year is one main "Transportation Informed Consent Form" which ALL parents will need to complete at the beginning of the school year. This will cover ALL bus travel for the year, including Mass and any other field trips within the city. The only time a separate consent form will be required is if the event has certain safety concerns (swimming, skiing) and/or is outside of the city limits.

Please complete the online consent form by following these steps:

- Log in to your PowerSchool Parent Portal on a web browser NOT the app - https://rdcrs.powerschool.com/public/home.html (If you do not remember your username or password, please contact the office).
- Scroll down and choose School Fees and Forms (second from the bottom, on the left)
- Select the student name from the top banner
- Select New Items, complete and submit the 2025/2026 In Town Transportation Consent
   Form

#### **Cell Phones and Personal Electronic Devices**

In June 2024, information was shared regarding the Province of Alberta's new guidelines regarding personal electronic device use in schools. Please see the letter from the Minister of Education - Minister's Letter to Parents. The following guidelines also align with the School Division's Administrative Procedure No. 114.

At St. Elizabeth Seton School, students are welcome to have their cell phones at school, as in many cases it allows families to communicate with each other before and after school. **During the school day**, however, cell phones must remain turned off and in student lockers, including at lunchtime, or during breaks during the school day. They are not to be used in the hallways, classrooms or outside during the school day, including indoor recess days.

- 1. <u>If any mobile device/earbuds/phones are seen or heard in class during non-designated times, the student will be asked to take their mobile device to the office. Parents will be notified on any occasion that this occurs.</u>
- 2. Devices delivered to the office will be returned at the end of the student's school day in the first and second instances. Should there be a third occurrence, a call will be made home, requiring a parent/quardian to collect the child's device.
- 3. Students can use their devices before school and after school. During these times, students are not to take photos or videos of others.
- 4. Students are not to access social media on the school network or school devices.
- Any students who require an exception to this policy at the school level will require permission
  from the school administration. Exceptions to this policy would include students who require
  personal devices for medical reasons or to support special learning needs.
